27. TECHNOLOGY UPGRADATION:

(1) Technology Up gradation in Teaching Aids:

OHP / LCD/ K-YAN are available in class Rooms.

(2) Technology Upgradation in Theory & Lab Courses:

- a) The concept of Green Chemistry adopted in UG Theory and lab courses by department of Chemistry to avoid the use of chemicals, reagents and solvents as well traditional methods to reduce or eliminate the use and generation of hazardous substances.
- b) Century old Classical Lessaigne's Test used for element detection in Organic Compounds is replaced by Green Method in which Organic compound is fused with Sodium carbonate and Zinc dust instead of sodium Metal.
- c) Test of Toxic metals - As, Cr (VI), Cd and Hg is made only demonstrative to avoid their passage to ecosystem.
- d) Corrosive reagents are replaced by Green reagents, the Corrosive liquid Bromine is replaced by Green reagents.
- e) Carcinogenic Organic solvents are replaced by aqueous medium wherever possible.

- d. Candidates with a rural background and belonging to the economically backward section of the society who reside eleven kilometers or more away from the college are also provided with a scholarship.

29. ACTIVITIES AND SUPPORT FROM THE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION:

The Alumni of the College have supported the College in various capacities depending on the position they are in.

1. Some of the prominent alumni of the college are in the field of basic and secondary education and they have covered the events of the college in a positive manner and presented and explained the viewpoint of the college to the various sections of the society.
2. Necessary, suggestions and feedback are provided by the Alumni Association from time to time and tried to be implemented.

30. ACTIVITIES AND SUPPORT FROM THE PARENTS-TEACHER ASSOCIATION:

The response of the Parents-Teacher Association is for the most part neutral. However, some parents do provide with the feedback and the college authorities do try to implement the feedback.

31. HEALTH SERVICES:

- a. Employees of the College being Government Employees are provided some benefits by the State Government. On production of certificate the State Government employees undergo free medical checkups and diagnostic tests such as Pathological Tests (Blood examination- routine, GBP, enzyme examination, urine examination, X-ray, Ultrasound, etc.). The reports however are a property of the state government.
- b. If the ailment is of serious nature and treatment at a higher centre is required Financial Assistance upto Rs. 40,000 can be reimbursed by the Principal on proper verification of the bills by the Chief Medical Superintendent. Expenses above 40,000 and below Rs. 1,00,000 are reimbursed by the Director. Reimbursement of bills above Rs.1,00,000 is done by the Principal Secretary Higher Education on proper verification of Bills.




DETAILS OF THE PLAN OF THE INSTITUTION FOR THE NEXT YEAR:
